9. Topical Issues of Romance Studies: Linguistic and Linguodidactic Aspects

Requirements for Abstracts of Reports:

- materials (no more than 2 pages) and two hard copies thereof must be submitted on a CD-R in Word 6.0 or 7.0 with the extension .doc without automatic hyphenation and their digital copies shall be sent to the Forum email: forum.inyaz@gmail.com

The information about the author(s) (full name, academic degree, academic title, workplace, position, home address with the indication of the postal code, telephone, email) must be submitted in a separate file and on a separate sheet of paper.

The digital media must contain two files: 1) abstracts of the report named by the author's last name spelled in Latin alphabet, e.g. ivanova.doc; 2) information about the author, e.g. ivanova_info.doc

- the centered title of the publication must be in bold type and in upper case (font size 14). The author(s)'s last name(s) and initials followed by the city name in brackets must appear under the title in regular letters;
- the manuscript body must be typed in Times New Roman font size 14 using line spacing of 1.5; margins: left, top and bottom margins must be 2.5 cm, right margins must be 1 cm. All paragraphs must be indented 5 spaces. Dash (–) and hyphen (-) must be clearly distinguished;
- special fonts or symbols, if any, must be submitted in separate files; illustrations, if any, must also be submitted in separate files;
- all pages of hard copies must be numbered in pencil on the back;
- all illustrative material must be italicized; the elements in the text that require highlighting must be underlined; meanings of words must be enclosed in quotation marks;
- All listed references must be cited in the text by using the citation number of the reference in the bibliography, e.g. S. Levinson [1, p. 38], where “1” is the consecutive number of the reference on the bibliography list and “p. 38” is the page of the quoted piece;
- abstracts should end with Literature (in bold and in regular letters with no left indentation). All references (including reference books) must be numbered consecutively and listed alphabetically with respect to the last name of the author (the last name of the first author, if there are several authors) in compliance with the standards of the Higher Attestation Commission of Ukraine as of 2008 (see Bulletin of the Higher Attestation Commission of Ukraine No. 3 as of 2008).

- if necessary, Illustrative Material is formatted likewise and follows the Literature section.
- footnotes must not be used.

Postgraduate students and applicants without academic degrees must also submit an extract from the minutes of their Department / Academic Council Meeting recommending the manuscript for publication.

Enclosing 2 stamped envelopes for further correspondence is appreciated.
The submitted materials will not be returned. The materials must be sent both by post and by email. The abstracts sent only by e-mail will not be accepted.

The abstracts, information about the author both in hard and digital (on a CD-R) copies along with 2 stamped envelopes for further correspondence and the receipt of the postal money order of the registration fee must be sent to the Forum Organizing Committee before **May 1, 2013**

The registration fee is UAH **250** (which covers publication of the Forum agenda, compendium of abstracts, and participation certificates, as well as the coffee-break and buffet dinner) should be sent by postal money order to the following address:
